SECTION 2 - HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

GHS signal word: WARNING

Hazard statement: May cause skin and eye irritation.

Precautionary statements: P264 Wash hands and exposed areas thoroughly after handling. P280 Wear eye protection and protective gloves. P302+P352 IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of water. P305+P351 IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes.

SECTION 3 - COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

Enzyme blend (trade secret): 1-10%

Fragrance (trade secret): 0.5%

Inorganic salts: <1%

Insoluble matter: <1%

SECTION 4 - FIRST-AID MEASURES

Eyes: Rinse cautiously with cool, clean water for at least 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.

Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly with soap and water for at least 20 minutes. Seek medical attention if irritation persists or a rash occurs.

Inhalation: Move the person to fresh air. Seek medical attention if symptoms occur.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. Rinse mouth and give cool water if the person is conscious. Contact the Poisons Information Centre (13 11 26) or a doctor. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

SECTION 5 - FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

Suitable extinguishing media: Use measures appropriate to the surrounding fire, including carbon dioxide, dry chemical, foam or water fog.

Specific hazards: Product is not flammable or combustible. Heated decomposition products or fire gases may be hazardous if inhaled.

Protective equipment: Firefighters should wear self-contained breathing apparatus and full protective equipment where appropriate.

SECTION 6 - ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Keep unnecessary personnel away. Avoid breathing vapours, spray or mist and use suitable personal protective equipment.

Prevent significant quantities from entering stormwater, drains, ditches or waterways. Stop the leak if safe. Contain with inert absorbent material such as sand, earth or vermiculite, collect into a labelled container and dispose of in accordance with applicable regulations.

Clean remaining traces with water, mop or cloth while preventing uncontrolled runoff.

SECTION 7 - HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling: Use with adequate ventilation. Avoid breathing spray, vapour or mist and avoid unnecessary eye and skin contact. Follow good hygiene practices and wash hands after use.

Storage: Keep container tightly closed in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place, protected from heat and direct sunlight. Do not store above 50°C. Keep out of reach of children.

SECTION 8 - EXPOSURE CONTROLS / PERSONAL PROTECTION

No product-specific workplace exposure standard was stated in the supplied SDS.

Engineering controls: Good general ventilation should normally be sufficient.

Eye protection: Safety glasses are recommended where splashing may occur.

Skin protection: Protective gloves are recommended for prolonged exposure or where indicated by the hazard classification.

Respiratory protection: Avoid creating mist. Use an approved respirator if exposure limits are exceeded or ventilation is inadequate.

SECTION 10 - STABILITY AND REACTIVITY

Stable under normal storage and handling conditions. No hazardous reactions are known from the supplied SDS. Avoid extreme heat. Do not mix with other cleaning chemicals unless expressly directed on the label.
